He eventually became a model client and a role model for incoming, younger Boulware clients. Daniel spent several months at the Mission and has since returned to Webster County where he continues to live a productive, self-sufficient life. He is employed and determined to remain sober. His biggest accomplishment has been mending relationships with his grown children; and he gets to spend time with his grandchildren which would previously not have been allowed.
