Green River Outreach Family Resource Center programming has changed its' approach to reaching families. Covid-19 changed students from learning in person to virtual. We could not hold gatherings for activities. So, if they cannot come to us we go to them. GRO FRC started a new program. It is called, "Book, Cook, and Craft". To reach the parents we designed a Facebook page to get the word out to parents. The parents contact the Resource Center to register. Each month we have a theme. Families receive a book, something to cook with their child, and a craft(per child) related to the book. We started in November and will continue through summer until school starts back. The response to the program has been great. It provides activities parents and children can do together. Many families do not have access to do things with their children due to Covid-19 restrictions or lack of money. This provided them with a fun thing they can do at home with no cost.
