Union County Senior Services Weekend Meal program was the first of its kind in our region. With the generous donation of additional United Way funds, we were able to develop this program over 5 years ago. In that time, we have delivered an additional meal to our homebound seniors weekly, ensuring they not only have food to feed them over the weekend, but also to help free up funds they may need for utilities, housing or pharmacy needs. Our greatest achievement is the amount of time this program has been able to consistently provide additional food for our homebound seniors. We provide a variety of easy to prepare meals, ranging from breakfast bowls, pancakes, freezer meals or soup and crackers. Without this program, the additional burden of providing food and not having additional money for necessities will fall of the backs of our homebound senior clients.

How Dollars Help Our Clients



\$100

\$100 will provide two weeks worth of weekend meals to our homebound clients.

\$500

\$500 will provide 200 weekend meals for our homebound clients.

\$1,000

\$1000 will provide a spot for a homebound client to be able to receive services through the Home Delivered Meal program. This will ensure 6 months of hot, nutritious meals delivered daily as well as the ability to participate in the Weekend Meal Program.
